DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Fire Chief Noah Halm – Be safe on the 4th of July it is dry out there. The Fire Department will be helping Rural 7 with the Demolition Derby.

Police Chief Mike Smith – 9th Circuit Court came out with a ruling on the Grants Pass issue on homeless encampments on public property. Would like the ordinance committee to get together and add it to the City's ordinance. The ordinance needs to read something to the terms of no camping in public areas except when permitted.

Mayor Dave Jones – Set up a Public Works Committee meeting for Tuesday July 9th at 3pm. The topic will be parking issues on Broadway Street. At the Wastewater Treatment Plant, the solid storage building has been completed. The asphalt drying pad is also completed. The screw press building is under construction and should be

done by the end of the week. Robert extended an invitation to any council member that would like a tour to get ahold of him or the mayor.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

Chief of Police Employee Agreement by Mayor Dave Jones - The Chief of Police position is an FLSA exempt position. On June 1, 2023, Mike Smith took over the position and is performing work without clear terms of his employment with the Employer. The attached Chief of Police Employee Agreement provides clear terms of working conditions that will protect the Employer and Employee rights equally and fairly.

Council Leadership and Organizational Change by LOREN MEAGHER- Would be beneficial to council and city staff if we had some workshops dedicated to organizational change. Setting a plan in place to review ordinances as well as addressing city planning and updating planning and zoning ordinances

Council Member Danielle Clevidence – We can partner with the county and other little cities to work hand in hand. When MRSC comes we can invite other local areas to be involved. If we could get into partnership without having to spend all of the money that would be a bonus and we would have more people to utilize in the future.

Council Member Miland Walling – He would like to have a workshop but would sooner wait until the new Public Works Director was hired.

Council Member Loren Meagher – Public Works Director role is council responsibility to determine the duties, responsibilities, and qualifications. We are creating a new Public Works position that has not been there for 15 years. I feel like that's a good council discussion that is well within the wheelhouse of the city council instead it's going to come back to us as this is done will you approve it. That's really not what we should be doing.

Council Member Steve Johnston – I believe there is already a job description to work with.

Council Member Loren Meagher – That has not been used for 15 years so council should take a look at that. The Public Works Director position should be a part of the initial workshop.

Motion: I move that we have a workshop on Saturday July 13th at 2pm Topics Public Works Director Position and City Council goals, **Action:** Motion, **Moved by** Council Member Danielle Clevidence, **Seconded by** Council Member Steve Johnston.

Police Chief Mike Smith – Brought up needing to create a full time Animal Control position.

Council Member Loren Meagher – I move to make a motion that Chief Mike Smith proposes staffing solutions for animal control and where that's housed and a budget.

Mayor Dave Jones – We should be able to direct the Chief of Police to do that under a Resolution.

Council Member Steve Johnston – With this position being full time would they be cruising the streets helping with some of the load.

Chief Mike Smith – No animal control is separate they are not a commissioned officer they are strictly animal control.

Rodger Nichols (Zoom) – Needed clarity before writing his report if Loren was stepping down.

Council Member Loren Meagher – After missing a number of council meetings I would be willing to step down and let someone else come in and have a voice.






